

Last Spring I read a book that suggested writing down scriptures on index cards to carry around and read throughout the day as a protection from the world. I thought it was a great idea and started looking for what he termed "victory scriptures" and wrote them down on colored index cards for my children.

At first I sent 7 scriptures each week. Now, once I have 7, I send them off. It's not as frequent because it takes a long time to write out 35 verses each week, plus, I don't want to overwhelm them too much.:) They have quite a stack now! (over 159) And I haven't even hardly touched the Bible!

It has been an incredible experience! I have come to understand how much the Lord loves us and has blessings waiting for us. And he's told us what we need to do to receive them. As he says in D&C 130:20-21, "There is a law, irrevocably decreed in heaven before the foundations of this world, upon which all blessings are predicated - And when we obtain any blessing from God, it is by obedience to that law upon which it is predicated." Many of these verses have the law and the enumerated blessings.

I want to share them with you. To me they are powerful scriptures and they have given me great strength and comfort as I have searched for and written them over and over for my children, As Nephi said, "And upon these (index cards) I write the things of my soul, and many of the scriptures which are engraven upon the plates of brass. For my soul delighteth in the scriptures, and my heart pondereth them, and writeth them for the learning and the profit of my children." Enjoy!
